The interventions include,


- Upgradation of PHC/CHC/Civil Hospitals etc. by infrastructure construction and providing apparatus • Donation of Ambulance
- Cleft lip surgery
 Medical Camp
- Awareness programme on Diabetes and Cancer
- Construction of waste bins, community toilets, drinking water etc.



Ambulance provided for emergency health care services to three villages particularly Saipum, Saiphai, and Mauchar, Kolasib, Mizoram covering more than 4000 population of the area. The Chairman of the Village Health Committee, Saipum, expressed that

it is an important intervention by NEEPCO for remotely located village like Saipum. Earlier we had to rely on ambulance service from the district head quarter and the response time was very high due to bad road condition. Now we have our own ambulance in place for quick and efficient response during emergency ***
