

Promoting Education:

Continuing with its tradition of giving high priority to the educational sector, NEEPCO has spent more than 25 % of the CSR budget on promoting education in the last five years. The objective of the scheme is to improve the infrastructure in educational institutions located in the vicinity of the project sites for better provision of education. The provision created by NEEPCO for the promotion of education indicates a certain positive impact and outcomes. (i) The scholarships boost the confidence of the students and keep their enthusiasm high to pursue education with full efforts without drawing any distractions arising out of their financial hardships, which also ensures that there are no dropouts of students at a higher level of education. (ii) Distribution of notebooks and school bags among the students from a poor economic background, though appears to be a petty intervention, to relieve the burden of poor parents, particularly those who survive on daily wage or earnings to a great extent. (iii) Construction of infrastructure such as class room, library, smart class rooms, toilets and drinking water facilities etc create a congenial environment for learning.

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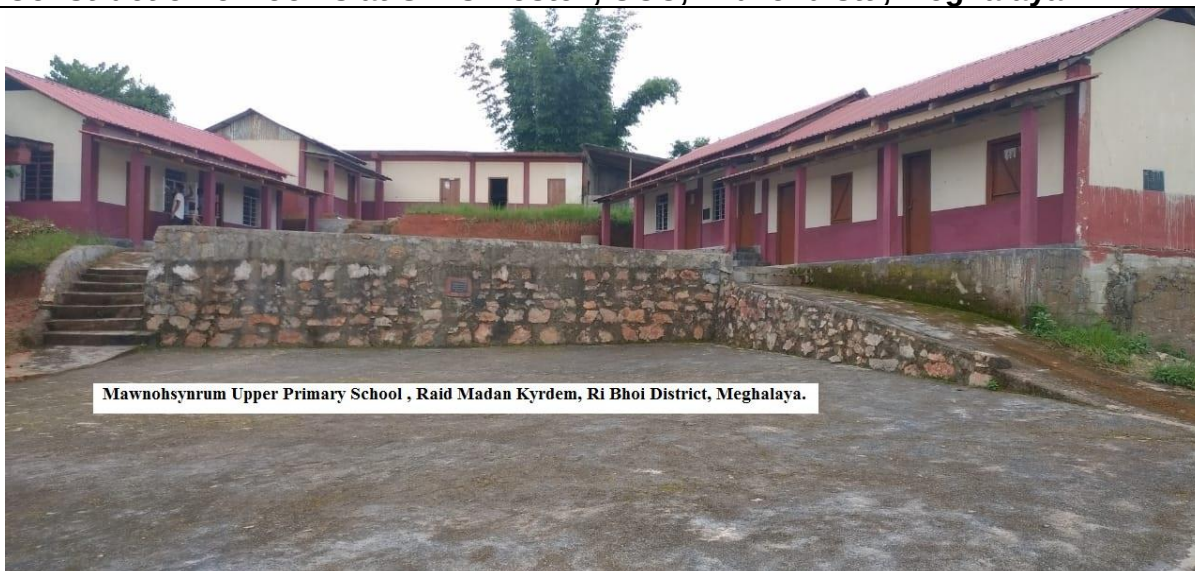
