

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:

The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 2nd October 2014, launched Swachh Bharat Abhiyan as a national movement. The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is the most significant cleanliness campaign by the Government of India. The campaign aims to achieve the vision of a 'Clean India'. As a part of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, during the years 2014-15 and 2015-16, NEEPCO has constructed 664 nos of school toilets under Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan. Under the programme NEEPCO is constructing toilets in its area of operation throughout the North East States.

NEEPCO has undertaken repairing of 143 nos. of school toilets which were become non-functional due to improper post -construction maintenance.
