CIRCULAR

Sub: School, State & National level Painting Competition on Energy Conservation-2024 for Group 'A' (5th, 6th & 7th Standard Students) and Group 'B' (8th, 9th & 10th Standard Students)

To sensitise the school children towards Energy Efficiency and Energy Conservation in the domestic sector, the Ministry of Power (MoP), Government of India (GoI), undertakes pan India National Awareness Campaign by organizing a Painting Competition for students. This Competition is also applicable to schools situated outside India. Participants from such schools would be judged separately for selecting National winners and separate prize money for Groups A & B.

METHODOLOGY OF PAINTING COMPETITION – 2024

School-Level Painting Competition

- School Principals are to visit www.paintings.beeindia.gov.in and register their schools.
- School to schedule a date and organize a painting competition of 2 hours duration for 5th, 6th & 7th Standard students under **Group 'A'** and for 8th, 9th & 10th Standard students under **Group 'B'**.
- Students must use A4 size sheets and painting materials such as pencils, colour pencils, crayons, water colours. Students can select any one of the above-mentioned themes.
- School principals shall select the 02 best paintings from each **Group A & B** and send them to the respective Nodal Officer of the State/UT. The list of Nodal Officers of States/UTs is available at www.paintings.beeindia.gov.in
- The paintings shall reach the respective Nodal Officer by **20th October 2024**.
- BEE / Nodal Officer of CPSU shall not be responsible for any delays for the entries not reaching by 20th October 2024.
- Details of the competition, terms & conditions, etc. are stated in the Methodology for National Painting Competition 2024 available on www.paintings.beeindia.gov.in and shall be binding.

State/UT Level Painting Competition

- Selected students from Groups A & B will be called for a two-hour on-the-spot Painting Competition to be held on 14th November 2024.

1st Prize – ₹50,000/- 2nd Prize – ₹30,000/- 3rd Prize – ₹20,000/-

10 Appreciation Prizes of ₹7,500 each

- Each participating student from Categories 'A' & 'B' will be paid ₹2000/- in cash (₹3000/- each to the participants from Lakshadweep) and a participation certificate (except for winners who will be provided winning certificates).

National Level Painting Competition

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of the State Level Painting Competition of the Group 'A' and 'B' from each State/UT will be invited to Delhi to participate in the "National Level Painting Competition" to be held on 11th December 2024.
- In the case of international participants, the 3 best Paintings of Group A & Group B each would be evaluated by BEE.
- International Paintings will be separately judged for winners of the National Level Painting Competition.
- National Level winners of both Groups 'A' & 'B' will be awarded prizes by the Chief Guest at the "National Energy Conservation Day Function" to be held in Delhi on 14th December 2024.

1st Prize – ₹1,00,000/- 2nd Prize – ₹50,000/- 3rd Prize – ₹30,000/-

10 Appreciation Prizes of ₹15,000 each

1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners would be provided with a laptop each and Appreciation prize winners with a tablet each

In the case of international winners, the number of awards shall be decided by the Jury and the only award prize would be given in terms of equivalent US\$.

NOTE

- Students who have won either 1st or 2nd or 3rd prize during State / National Level Painting 2021 or 2022 or 2023 within the Group are not eligible to participate in the competition at any level of competition. However, 1st or 2nd or 3rd prize winners of Group A can participate in Group B, if eligible.
- Use of Collage/Patchwork is not permitted in the paintings at all levels of competition.
- Paintings selected at School Level, State/UT, International Level and National Level would be the sole property of BEE, which will have the right to use it for any purpose it considers appropriate.
- The decision of the Jury/Expert Committee at all levels of the painting competition will be final & no correspondence shall be entertained.
