## About Us

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation (NEEPCO) Limited is a Miniratna Schedule "A" Government of India Enterprise under the Ministry of Power. The company was set up on April 2, 1976 with the objective to plan, investigate, design, construct, generate, operate and maintain power stations in the NER (North Eastern Region) of the country. With headquarter in Shillong, the capital of Meghalaya, the company today is the major supplier of power in the northeastern region. The company's present authorized share capital stands at Rs. 5000 crores and its net worth at Rs. 5988.28 crores.

The present installed capacity of the company stands at 1287 MW. Currently the company is operating 5 hydro, 3 thermal and 1 solar power stations contributing about 40 percent of the total power generation in the region. Besides, the company has 4 power projects under development which include 110 MW Pare HEP, 600 MW Kameng HEP, 60 MW Tuirial HEP and one 25 MW Solar Project in JV mode.
