Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi on 22nd September 2025 laid the foundation stone for Heo (240 MW) & Tato-I (186 MW) Hydro Projects in Arunachal Pradesh – a step towards making the North East India's power hub.





Cabinet approves Investment Proposal for construction of 700 MW Tato-II Hydro Electric Project in Shi Yomi District of Arunachal Pradesh with an outlay of Rs.8146.21 crore and completion period of 72 months.

The project with an installed capacity of 700 MW (4 x 175 MW) will produce 2738.06 MU of energy 12.08.2025



NEEPCO successfully achieved the first-time synchronization of 23 MW Khandong Unit - 2 on 22.08.2025 after completion of Renovation Modernization and Life Extension of the Unit. Unit 1 was successfully synchronised to grid at 20:40 Hrs on 04.06.2025 after completion of R&M and LE.








BIDDING ADIEU
