NEEPCO signed MoU with Central Water commission (CWC) on 28.10.2024 for consultancy of conducting Glaciers Lake Outburst Floods (GLOF) studies of Siyom Basin Projects.

CABINET APPROVES INVESTMENT PROPOSAL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF 186 MW TATO-I HYDRO ELECTRIC PROJECT IN SHI YOMI DISTRICT OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved investment of Rs.1750 crore for construction of Tato-I Hydro Electric Project (HEP) in Shi Yomi District of Arunachal Pradesh. The estimated completion period for the project is 50 months.

The project with an installed capacity of 186 MW (3 x 62 MW) would produce 802 Million Units (MU) of energy. The Power generated from the Project will help improve the power supply position in the state of Arunachal Pradesh and will also help in balancing of the national Grid. The Project will be implemented through a Joint Venture Company between North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd. (NEEPCO) and the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. Government of India shall extend Rs.77.37 crore as budgetary support for construction of roads, bridges and associated transmission line under enabling

infrastructure besides Central Financial Assistance of Rs.120.43 crore towards equity share of the State.

The state would be benefitted from 12% free power and another 1% towards Local Area Development Fund (LADF) besides significant infrastructure improvement and socio-economic development of the region.

There will be significant improvement in infrastructure, including the development of around 10 kilometres of roads and bridges, for the project which shall be mostly available for local use. The district will also benefit from the construction of essential infrastructure such as hospitals, schools, vocational training institutes like ITIs, marketplaces, playgrounds, etc. to be financed from dedicated project funds of Rs.15 crore. Local populace shall also be benefitted from many sorts of compensations, employment and CSR activities.

Shri Ritesh Guha Roy, from Tripura won the 1st prize in Group B.

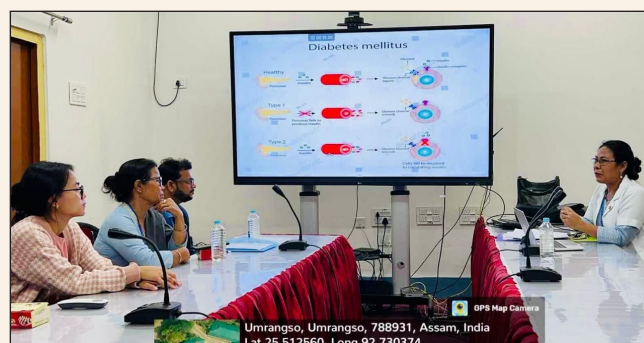

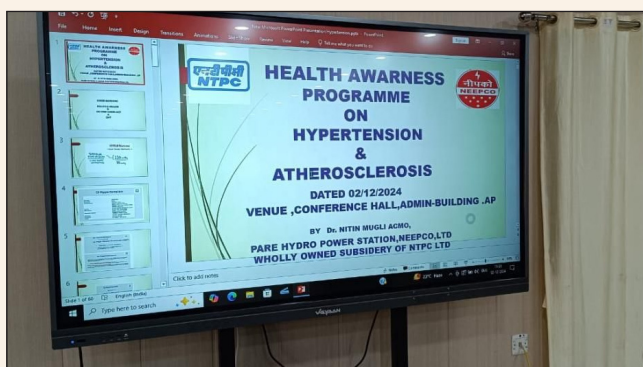

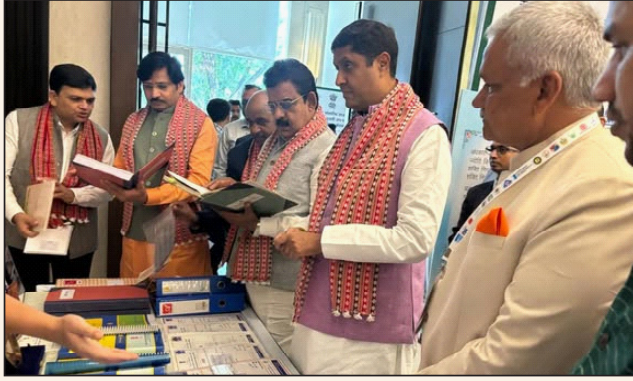
A health check up programme of the cooks and hired vehicle drivers was arranged at Kimi, Arunachal Pradesh by KaHPS on 22.11.2024.
