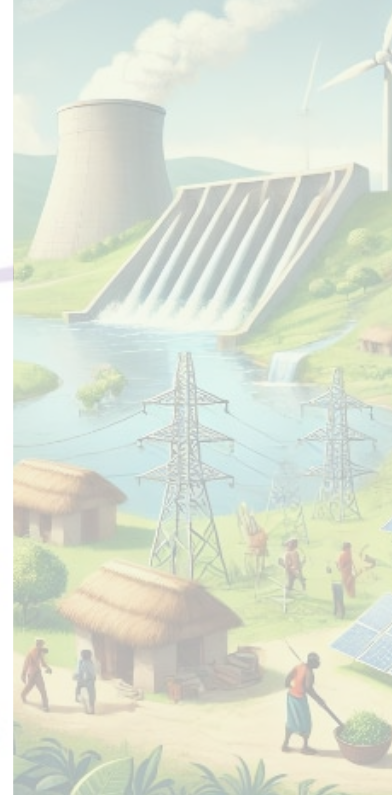

Achieving a significant milestone in execution of 2X23 MW Renovation, Modernization and Life- Extension of the Plant on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2025 the Rotor of the Khandong Unit #1 was lowered in presence of Shri S. Deka CGM(Tech)/ HoP, Shri A.Kalita EIC, HODs, site engineers & M/s Voith's representatives.



A major milestone was completed of Renovation, Modernization and Life Extension of 2X23 MW Khandong Power Station. The Stator of Unit 1 was lowered into the generator barrel in presence of HoP, CGM (Tech), O&M, EIC and site engineers on 19.02.2025

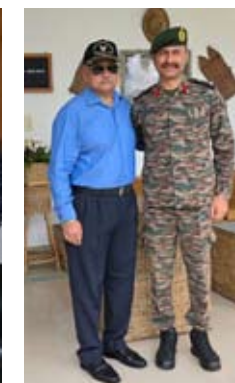

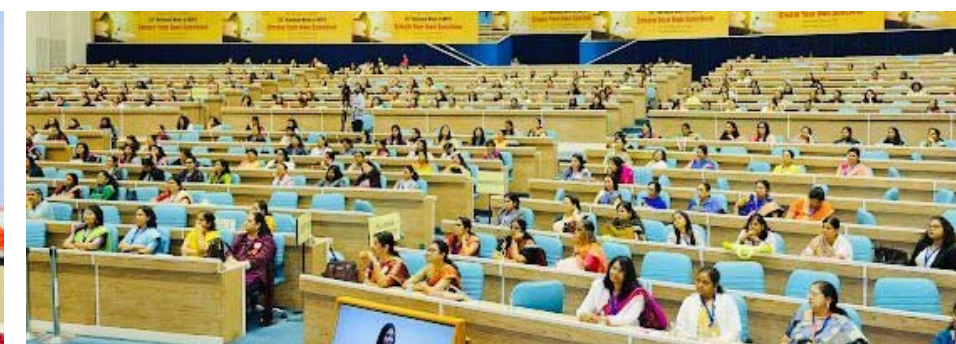
