

ESCAPE THROUGH INFERNO MOCK DRILL CONDUCTED

Drill of Disaster Management /Emergency Plan Scenario was conducted Corporate HQ on the scenario -"Escape Through Inferno" in association with State Fire & Emergency Service, East Khasi Hills District, Government of Meghalaya, Shillong on January 2013, at Corporate Head Quarter, Shillong to make our employees familiar with various procedures of Disaster Management Emergency Plan like;



Evacuation, Fist-Aid Fire-Fighting technique, Major Fire-Fighting & Rescue Operations etc.

The scenario was created at two different locations, one at top floor of D3-D4 block and another on the ground near overhead water storage tank. First - Aid Fire-Fighting operation was done through departmental portable Fire Extinguishers and Fire Tender of State Fire & Emergency Service. All the occupants were evacuated within one minute from the D3-D4 block. After completion of all operations, a

short briefing was delivered to the gathering by Shri V.S. Choudhury, Sr. Manager (F&S) and Shri M. Rymbai, Station Officer, State Fire & Emergency Service, Shillong, Meghalaya.

The National Safety Day followed by safety week was observed at the Corporate Office from the 4th to 10th March 2013. Safety pledge was administered by Shri V. S. Choudhury, Sr. Manager (F&S). Safwety awareness campaign was launched with various safety slogans and campaign materials during the week.

CMD, D(T) ALONG WITH OTHER DIGNITARIES FROM NHPC VISITED KaHEP




The 4 × 150 MW KaHEP achieved a major milestone in the construction programme on 28th December 2012. The break-through blast between Face XIII and faces XVI & XVII of the high pressure tunnel was taken by Shri P. C. Pankaj, CMD on the 28th December' 2012, in presence of Shri U. Moral, D(T) and other officials.

Due to extremely poor rock condition, excavation of the faces XVI & XVII from powerhouse end was considered to be risky for the safety of the powerhouse as well as the 400 KV Switchyard. However, by exercising caution, the boring of these tunnel faces have been completed successfully. With

the above break-through, the entire underground tunnel boring from Tenga Dam to Kimi powerhouse, comprising of 4.7 km long HRT and 2.06 km long HPT, has been completed. With this achievement, KaHEP has earned excellent rating in the boring of H.P.T. as per MoU. during the current financial year 2012-2013.

On 29th December 2012, CMD along with D(T), NEEPCO and dignitaries from NHPC had visited Bichom dam site. They were accompanied by HoP KaHEP, GM Project (Hydro), Guwahati and other officials of the project. The dignitaries had thread bear



discussion with the officials of Bichom dam sites as well as with the officials of M/S. PEL and after having discussion, the CMD had instructed the concerned officials of the project as well as the contractor of M/S, PEL to carry out the construction works of dam on war footing manner so as to achieve another milestone on time. On the way back from Bichom, the dignitaries had visited Tenga dam site and had interactions with the officials on the progress of the works. After visiting Tenga dam site, the dignitaries left the site at around 6.00 p.m. for Tezpur.


MOCK DRILL CONDUCTED

A 45 minutes disaster management mock drill was conducted by Shri M. Saikia, Safety Officer at KHEP on 30th November 2012. The drill started with prolonged signal of the siren at 10-45 a.m. water tender arrived at office complex and started a demonstration on how to extinguished fire. Portable fire extinguishers were also used to extinguish fire. All the employees came out to an open area. Medical team was called to provide medical aids to the victim and fire warders rescued the affected person from the office building and carried them to the ambulance. With the help of fire warders/security personnel, the drill was completed within 45 minutes
