SC directs states to frame media briefing policies within 3 months

The court said states could draw from senior advocate Sankaranarayanan's 'Police Manual on Media Briefing'.

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court has directed states to frame and notify comprehensive media briefing policies for criminal cases within three months in a move aimed at preventing media trials, prejudicing investigations, and violating the privacy of both victims and accused.

The court expressed dissatisfaction over the lack of seriousness shown so far in regulating how police communicate with the media during investigations.

A bench of justices MM Sundresh and N Kotswar Singh said that states could draw from a detailed "Police Manual on Media Briefing" prepared by senior advocate Gopal Sankaranarayanan, who was assisting the court as amicus curiae, while evaluating their own tailored policies.

"We deem it appropriate to direct the states to evolve an appropriate policy for Media Briefing by taking into consideration the Police Manual for Media Briefing furnished by the learned Ami-

cus Curiae. The needful will have to be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order," the bench said in its January 15 order, which was released on Wednesday.

The court noted that despite earlier directions and deliberations, states had not shown "adequate interest" in putting in place safeguards to ensure that police briefings do not result in media trials, prejudice investigations, or violate the dignity and privacy of victims and accused.

The directions came in a public interest litigation filed by the Peoples Union for Civil Liberties (PUCL) in 1999, which flagged the

absence of clear guidelines governing police encounters and media briefings by law enforcement agencies. Several connected appeals by individuals were also being heard with the case.

During a hearing in November last year, the top court had sought responses from the Centre and states on the draft manual, calling the exercise "unprecedented" and granting eight weeks for governments to study and respond to the document. At the time, the court described the 61-page manual as an "exhaustive" effort and said states must carefully examine it before the court considered issuing binding directions.

The manual lays down a rights-compatible framework for police communication, stressing that media briefings must balance the public's right to timely and accurate information with the dignity, privacy and fair-trial rights of victims, witnesses and suspects. It mandates that all disclosures pass four tests: legality, necessity, proportionality and accountability, and be issued only through designated spokespersons after vetting.

SIT rules out foul play in 17-yr-old Bihar NEET aspirant's death case

PATNA: The special investigation team (SIT), probing into the mysterious death case of a 17-year-old NEET aspirant in Bihar's Patna, on Wednesday said they have found no trace of any untoward incident that led to the student's death, citing electronic evidence.

A senior SIT official further refuted to the reports of people being detained for questioning in the case, or any arrests being made from Jehanabad. All action would be evidence-based, he said.

The girl was initially taken to Prabhat Memorial hospital and later admitted to Medanta Hospital in Patna on January 10, where she died the next day.

The unrest in Sambhal followed a court-ordered survey of the Shahi Jama Masjid on November 19, 2024, after claims that a Harihara temple earlier stood at the site.

Sambhal tehsildar Dhirendra Pratap Singh said the property attachment was carried out under Section 84 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) as per court directions against the absconding accused.

Krishna Bishnoi, Superintendent of police (SP), said police have received information that Sharif, while based in Dubai, is allegedly involved in gold smuggling and further probe is on.
