CORRIGENDUM NO. 3 DATED 01-08-2025

(INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING)

Name of Work: Package-III: Civil Works of Power Intake, Head Race Tunnel, Surge Shaft, Valve chamber, Pressure Shafts & Penstock, Underground Powerhouse Complex (comprising of Powerhouse Cavern, Transformer - GIS Cavern, Collection Chamber, Main Access Tunnel (MAT), Cable Access Tunnel (CAT)) Unit Tail Race Tunnels, Main Tail Race Tunnel, Pothead Yard and various Construction Adits pertaining to Tato-II Hydro Electric Project (700 MW), Arunachal Pradesh.

Following corrigenda to the bid document are hereby issued:

Part- 1: Short & Detail NIB

1. The provisions stipulated in Clause No. 6.2.2 (i) (a) of Part-1: Short & Detail NIB of Bid Document and subsequent modifications issued vide Corrigendum No. 1 Dtd. 04.07.2025 stand modified as below:

Tunnel of not less than 5.20 m diameter (Finished)- Completion of Excavation and Concrete Lining of at least 1500 m in a single Tunnel with continuous boring length of more than 500 m in completed/ ongoing project.

2. The provisions stipulated in Clause No. 6.2.2 (i) (b) of Part-1: Short & Detail NIB of Bid Document and subsequent modifications issued vide Corrigendum No. 1 Dtd. 04.07.2025 stand modified as below:

Underground shaft – Completion of excavation, support of at least one shaft of minimum 3 m finished diameter and minimum 100 m height in completed/ongoing project.

3. The provisions stipulated in 1st Para of Clause No. 6.2.3 of Part-1: Short & Detail NIB of Bid Document stand modified as below:

Documentary evidence in support of the above experience indicating details like scope of work; value of works executed; date of completion/substantial completion/physical progress of the work; name & address including contract no., email address of the clients/employers/owners; satisfactory completion/substantial completion/physical progress of work shall be furnished along with the Techno commercial bids for establishing eligibility in terms of the Qualifying requirements. The documents should be in the form of copies of Work Order and certificate of completion/substantial completion/physical progress from clients/ employers/ owners.

4. The provisions stipulated in Clause No. 6.4.1 (vi) of Part-1: Short & Detail NIB of Bid Document stand modified as below:



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Bidder, by itself or Joint Venture/ Consortium shall collectively satisfy, as a whole, the requirements specified under Paras 6.1, 6.2 & 6.3, fulfilling the conditions, under **clause no. 6.4.1**. Relevant experience of each partner shall be counted for the purpose of assessing experience of this Joint Venture/Consortium.

However, parties claiming to have past experience by virtue of being a partner of Joint Venture/Consortium, while executing particular works in the past, shall have to produce documentary evidence of their role and scope of work in the aforesaid Joint Venture/ Consortium, which shall be counted for the purpose of assessing experience of this Joint Venture/ Consortium.

In case scope of work of individual partners is not clearly defined in the JV/ agreement then credential of Bidders being partner in a JV/ shall be decided in the following manner:

- a) Where Specific experience certificate in respect of individual JV partners is available, the same shall be considered to the extent of work executed by such JV partner.
- b) Where Specific experience certificate is not available, or experience certificate is issued in the name of JV/, the evaluation shall be done in the following manner:
 - i) In case the participation / profit sharing percentage of Bidders as per JV agreement is at least 35%, full credit of the work executed by the JV/ shall be given to such Bidders.
 - ii) In case the participation / profit sharing percentage of Bidder in JV agreement is less than 35%, no credit of work executed under such JV shall be given to such Bidder.
 - iii) Notwithstanding (i) and (ii) above, in case of availability of Specific experience certificate, (a) above shall apply.

In case both participations share and profit-sharing ratio are available in the JV Agreement, participation share shall prevail.

For the portion of work executed through a Sub-Contractor, full experience for that portion of work can be claimed by the contractor as well as Sub-Contractor for fulfilling criteria for evaluation of Bidder's experience.

Part- 3: Instruction to Bidder (ITB)

5. The provisions stipulated in Part-II under Clause No. 23.1 (ii) of Part-3: ITB of Bid Document stand modified as below:

Comparison of Price bids (Envelope 2) of the accepted Techno-Commercial Bids.

Part- 4: General Conditions of Contract (GCC) (FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Construction, 1st Edition, 1999, Red Book), Particular Conditions of Contract (PCC), Appendix to Tender

6. The provisions stipulated in 1st para from start of Clause No. 4.2 of Part-4: PCC of Bid Document stand modified as below:



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The Contractor shall deliver Performance Security to the Employer within 21 (twenty one) days of issue of Letter of Acceptance. The Performance Security shall be in the form of a Bank Guarantee (including e-Bank Guarantee) or Insurance Surety Bond, as stipulated by the Employer in the Appendix to Tender. The Performance Security of a Joint Venture shall be in the name of individual partner of Joint Venture in proportion of its participation share.

7. The provisions stipulated in 8th para from start of Clause No. 4.2 of Part-4: PCC of Bid Document may be read as below:

The Contractor may submit the Performance Security including additional Performance Security in the form of account payee Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit Receipt / online payment also. The Demand Draft should be drawn on Nationalised Bank/Scheduled bank only located in the country of the Employer in favour of NEEPCO Ltd. payable at Shillong.

8. The provision stipulated in last sentence of Para (a) of Payment Through Escrow Account under Clause No. 14.7: Payment of Part-4: PCC of Bid Document may be read as below:

The designated Escrow Account shall be opened by the Contractor after LOA with an Indian Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Commercial Bank.

9. The percentage of retention money stipulated in Clause No. 14.3 of Appendix to Tender under Part-4: PCC of Bid Document stands modified as @2.5% (two-point five percent).

10. The Periods for Submission of Insurance under Clause 18.1 of Part-4: PCC of Bid Document is added in the Appendix to Tender of PCC as below:

Periods for submission of insurance:		
(a) evidence of insurance	18.1	90 days
(b) relevant policies	18.1	90 days

All others terms and conditions of the Bid Document and Corrigendum No. 1 Dtd. 04.07.2025 shall remain unchanged.
