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**Corrigendum XIV**

With reference to **NIB No. NEEPCO/PEN/IND/001**, point-wise clarification on the bid queries is detailed below:

Sl. No.	Query	Clarification
1.	"Factor of Safety" specified for the design is 5. Is this factor of safety only for the FRP or for the steel as well?	The Specified Factor of Safety is for FRP only.
2.	For carrying out the lining, we would require sufficient closed storage space for our raw materials. Would this provision be available at the site or should we arrange for the same?	Point No. 28 of Pre- Bid Meeting Queries may be referred.
3.	While carrying out the lining of Penstock- 2, would Penstock- 1 be in operation? If yes, we propose removal of the first ferrule of penstock- 2 as a safety measure to avoid the Penstock from flooding by accident while the works are being carried out. Kindly confirm if this can be done.	Penstock- 1 shall be in operation while carryout the lining works in Penstock- 2. However, there will not be any likelihood of flooding of Penstock- 2.
4.	Kindly let us know, if accommodation shall be available for our engineers, supervisors and technicians at site.	Point No. 24 of Pre- Bid Meeting Queries may be referred.
5.	We note that bidders need to submit an EMD of Rs. 3 Crores along with the bid. Usually in government projects EMD is not applicable for SME Companies. Thus can we take a deviation to the submission of EMD against submission of our SME certificate.	Bid conditions for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) is enclosed at <b>Annexure 1.</b>

All other terms and conditions contained in the Detailed Bid Documents shall remain unchanged.



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### Annexure 1 - Corrigendum XIV

Additional clause 6.6 after 6.5 under clause 6 of Part 1 is detailed as follow:

**6.6 Conditions for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs):** (Applicable only for Bidders where either the Individual Bidder or both partners of the JV / Consortium belong to India)

- (i) The bidders participating as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) shall submit an Undertaking in the prescribed format given in **Form-I, Part-6 of Bid Document** declaring the status of their firm under the provisions of Micro and Small Enterprises along with a copy of the document/ certificate issued by any of the Authority mentioned below:
- District Industries Centers (DICs)
  - Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)
  - Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB)
  - Coir Board
  - National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
  - Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom
  - MSEs registered under Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM)
  - Any other Body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MoMSME)
- (ii) The registration certificate submitted by MSEs issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on close date of the tender. The successful bidder should ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period. The MSEs who have applied for registration or renewal of registration with any of the above agencies/bodies, but have not obtained the valid certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption/preference.
- (iii) The MSEs owned by Scheduled Caste (SC) & Scheduled Tribe (ST) entrepreneurs must submit the SC/ST certificate issued by District Authority

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in addition to certificate of registration with any one of the agencies mentioned above. The bidder shall furnish necessary documentary evidence to ascertain that the MSE is owned by SC/ST. MSE owned by SC/ST is defined as:

- a) In case of proprietary MSE, proprietor(s) shall be SC /ST.
  - b) In case of partnership MSE, the SC/ST partners shall be holding at least 51% shares in the enterprise.
  - c) In case of Private Limited Companies, at least 51% share shall be held by SC/ST promoters.
- (iv) The MSEs registered with above mentioned agencies/bodies are exempted from payment of BID FEES and EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD).
- (v) Since the instant procurement is specialised type of work related to public safety, accordingly, no other preferences pertaining to price and qualifying requirement shall be applicable.
