Subject: Third Party RTI Audit Summary Report (FY 2023-24) for North Eastern Electric Power Corporation (NEEPCO)

The Right to Information Act, which allowed the citizen unprecedented access into information under the control of public authorities, has multiple dimensions. The most commonly known and, equally widely utilized, is the straight forward filing of requests by the information seekers and the subsequent process of first and second appeals. This is the demand side of the transparency law.

The other dimension, which is the law's supply-side, is a scheme of voluntary disclosure of information by public authorities (PAs) through a variety of means, principal among which is the disclosure through websites.

Section 4 of the RTI Act provides the broad outline of the content of the websites.

Disclosures under this section are expected to: i) enable the citizen to access the information held by PAs without their having to take recourse to the provisions of RTI Act; and, b) promote transparency and accountability in the functioning of the government to promote participatory governance.

We appreciate the sincere efforts of **North_Eastern_Electric_Power_Corporation** as Public Authority for sharing required information on website to maintain the transparency. It has been observed during the Audit that the information relating to few areas has to be shared on website with more clarity.

NPTI would like to share positive feedback that in future all the required information/urls/links may be posted on web site to meet the Transparency Audit Questionnaire.
