6. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 10% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. 7. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. 1. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. **Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

3. **Generic**

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

4. **Generic**

Approach to Kameng Hydro Power Station, Kimi, Arunachal Pradesh

The Kameng Hydro Power Station, Kimi is located in the West Kameng District of the State of Arunachal Pradesh. The approximate distances by road between Guwahati (Assam) and Delivery location i.e. Project Site (Kimi in Arunachal Pradesh) is 300 Km. Approximately 30 Km of approach from main road to Project site is unsurfaced Road in hilly terrain.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

The Insulating Synthetic Mats should conform to the following:

1) General:

- a. Nominal thickness of the Insulating Mat 3.0 mm.
- b. **Width 1.0 Meter.**
- c. **Roll Length up to 15.0 Meters.**
- d. **Color: Blue**
- e. Synthetic high voltage Insulating Mats as per latest IS 15652:2006.
- f. Di-electric strength 66 kV.
- g. Insulating Mats should be Fire retardant, water & moisture proof.
- h. Insulating Mats should not be adversely affected by acids, alkalis, diesel and transformer oil. Mats should have good mechanical properties to withstand load and movement of breaker trolley.
- i. Insulating Mats should be manufactured without any metallic derivatives.
- j. Insulating Mats should be suitable for both AC and DC electrical insulation.

k. Insulating Mats should be 100% shockproof with leakage current of less than 10 mA at 33 kV.

2. Features:

a. Insulating Synthetic Mats should have ISI mark, month & year of manufacture, lot/batch number, manufacturers and owner name embossed/printed on the mats at every meter of length.

b. Name of manufacturer:

c. Brand Name:

d. Name of Owner: Kameng Hydro Power Station

3. Composition:

a. The Insulating Mats should be made from elastomers, free from any insertions leading to deterioration of the insulating properties.

b. The upper surface of the Insulating Mats shall have small aberrations to avoid slippery effects while the lower surface should be plain and should be finished slip resistance without affecting adversely the dielectric properties of the Mats.

4. Workmanship and finish: Insulating Mats should be free on both surface from harmful physical irregularities that can be detected by thorough tests & inspection.

5. Packing: The Insulating Mats shall be packed either in rolls or flats and shall not be distorted mechanically.

6. Tests on Insulating Mats: Routine tests should be conducted and test reports submitted for approval by the corporation, prior to dispatch of materials. No materials should be dispatched without approval of test certificates and grant of dispatch clearance.

Terms & Conditions

1. Terms of Payment

For Supply- 100% of the contract price along with applicable GST and F&I charges shall be released after receipt of materials at site in full and good condition.

For Installation/Fixing- 100% Charges shall be paid after successful installation/Fixing of all the quantities of insulating mats.

2. Transit Insurance-

Consignment shall be insured by the supplier against possible loss/damage during transportation. Insurance coverage shall be up to receipt of material at site and 30(thirty) days thereafter to facilitate intimation of transit loss/damage, if any. Any loss /damage during transit shall be intimated to the supplier within a reasonable time from the date of receipt of material by consignee and the supplier shall take immediate action for replacement/rectification of loss/damage. The supplier shall have the sole liability/responsibility for settlement of claim with the insurer towards loss/damage, if any, and therefore, replacement/rectification of the loss/damage shall be made good immediately and without waiting for settlement of claim.

3. Liquidated Damage-

If the performance of the contract is delayed beyond the stipulated time due to reasons attributable to the contractor, the purchaser shall without prejudice to his right, recover the following damages for breach of contract.

Reduce the contract price by ½ % (Half percent) per week or part thereof of delay in completion time, subject to maximum of 10% (ten percent) of Contract price.

4. Testing-

The contractor shall get all test reports approved from the purchaser before despatch of material. The purchaser shall issue despatch clearance after test reports are found satisfactory.

5. Packing, Forwarding & Shipment-

The contractor shall be responsible for securely protecting and packing the materials as per prescribed standards for ensuring safety of material during transit, so as to avoid damage under normal conditions of transport, handling and storage at site till the time of installation. The contractor shall be responsible for any loss or damage during transportation, handling and storage due to improper packing.

Each bundle or package shall have following marking on it.

- a. Name and address of Consignee
- b. Relevant marks, reference numbers etc for identification.
- c. Directions for handling the material.

Each package shall also be accompanied with detailed packing list to facilitate checking up of the contents at destination.

The contractor shall notify the purchaser of the date of despatch from his works, and expected date of arrival at site for the information of the purchaser. The contractor shall also give all despatch information concerning the weight, size and content of each package including any other information the purchaser may require.

All demurrage, wharfage and other expenses incurred due to delayed clearance of the material and which are attributable to the contractor on transportation shall be to the account of the contractor.

Contractor is to arrange for all handling viz unloading of material at site etc.

6. Guarantee-

All material supplied shall be guaranteed for a period of 18 months from the date of despatch. The contractor shall guarantee the following

- a. Use of best quality and strength of material
- b. Satisfactory performance during the period of Operation & Maintenance Period.

The contractor shall guarantee that the material shall be new and of best quality workmanship and the material shall have no defect in design and /or manufacturing and shall meet requirements of the specifications and shall be in all respects suited for purposes intended.

The contractor shall remedy, without any cost to the owner, all defects in design, materials and workmanship which may develop under normal use and which have been called to the attention of the contractor prior to the expiry of the warranty period.

7. Rejection of Defective material-

If material supplied is found to be defective in full or in part or fail to fulfil the requirements of the contract, the purchaser shall give the contractor notice stating the particulars of such defects or failure and the contractor shall forthwith make the defect good, or later the same, to make it comply with requirements of the contract.

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8. Installation/Fixing of Insulating Mat-

- a. On receipt of materials, the purchaser shall intimate the supplier. The supplier shall deputise its service personnel as and when intimated for which 10(ten) days notice shall be given.
- b. Local conveyance at site shall be arranged by NEEPCO
- c. Accommodation for service/technical personnel shall be provided by NEEPCO on chargeable basis.
- d. Our requirement is supply and installation of 855 Sq. Meter of insulating mat.
