The undersigned on behalf of NEEPCO Ltd. invites **online electronic bids** through e-tendering process from the reputed Firms under Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding system through Domestic Competitive Bidding (DCB) route for "Supply of various tools & equipment and furniture items for National Skill and Training Institute (NSTI) at Tura, Meghalaya, F.O.R. at Tura, Meghalaya." with 90 (Ninety) days validity from the date of opening of the Bid.

1. **Scope of Work**: Supply of various tools & equipment and furniture items for National Skill and Training Institute (NSTI) at Tura, Meghalaya, F.O.R. at Tura, Meghalaya. The detail scope of supply and specification of items will be as per the list of items as indicated in the BOQ (Price Bid).

2. Participation in Bids

2.1 E-Tendering / E-Procurement:

This tender is being processed through e-tendering/e-procurement system. The bidding documents are to be downloaded from https://etenders.gov.in and bids are to be submitted/ uploaded through above e-tendering system. Guidelines for e- tendering system are available on e- tender portal.

- 2.2 Registration for Participation in Bids:
 - a. Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrolment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
 - b. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
 - c. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
 - d. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
 - e. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
 - f. Bidder can then log in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

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3. Credentials and other documents to be furnished with the techno-commercial bid:

- a) Bid Fees of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only including 18 % GST (SAC Code 9954) (NEEPCO Guwahati GST NO.: 18AAACN9991J6ZM). Applicable bank charges shall be borne by the bidder.
 - The bidder shall make the payment in the form of DD/CDR/FDR/BANK DRAFT from any Nationalised Scheduled Bank in India, drawn in favour of NEEPCO Ltd. payable at Shillong.
- b) Documentary evidence in support of experience for supply of items/materials to Central Govt., State Govt, Public Sector Units etc. with Detailed Supply Order.

Detailed Bid document can be downloaded from this website after vendor registration. In the online Bid submission, Bidders will submit their Bids using their digital signature.
- 4.2 Submission of online bid is mandatory.
- 4.3 Bidders may view the tender opening results in https://etenders.gov.in by marking their presence for online tender opening.

The bid shall be evaluated on lowest rate basis of all the items mentioned in the Price Bid.

General Terms & Conditions

1. **Name of work:** Supply of various tools & equipment and furniture items for National Skill and Training Institute (NSTI) at Tura, Meghalaya, F.O.R. at Tura, Meghalaya

2. Price:

Rate shall be quoted F.O.R. at site as per BOQ (Price Bid) both in figures and words.

Bidders are to quote their rates per unit of the materials as mentioned in the BOQ (Price Bid) which includes all applicable taxes/duties/levies, Freight, Transit Insurance and other charges as applicable.

The Rate shall be considered approximating nearest to Rupee.

Supplier will be fully responsible for all loses/damages/shortages in transit up to destination of delivery.

No conditional offer/bids will be accepted. Bids with any conditions, whatsoever, which are in deviation to the terms and conditions specified in this Detailed Bid Document are liable for rejection.

3. Price Escalation:

The rate quoted shall remain firm for the entire Contract Period and Extended Period, if any thereof and no Escalation Payment on this account will be entertained by the Corporation.

4. **Delivery**:

The materials shall be delivered within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of the Supply Order.

5. Location of Delivery of materials:

The materials shall be delivered at National Skill and Training Institute (NSTI) at Tura, Meghalaya.

6. Quantity Variation: Quantity indicated in BOQ (Price Bid) is Fixed.

7. Transit Insurance:

Transit Insurance to be borne by the Supplier.

8. Payment:

Payment shall be released within 30 (Thirty) days from the date of delivery of Materials at site on submission of Bills in triplicate to the Consignee in all respect.

9. Penalty/Liquidated damages:

The delivery period for supply will be the essence of the Order. If the Supplier fails to supply within the stipulated delivery period as indicated in the Purchase Order without valid and convincing reasons, penalty will be levied to the extent of 0.5 % (zero point five percent) per week of delay subject to maximum of 10 % (ten percent) of the Order value of the goods.

Force Majeure:

(i) Within stipulated Delivery Period, if delay occurs due to "FORCE MAJEURE" conditions, which are beyond the control of the Supplier, payment of penalty as

mentioned above by the Supplier to NEEPCO Ltd. on account of delay in delivery may be waived. The supplier shall, however, apply to the executing authority for waival of payment of Penalty/Liquidated damages in such cases, supported by documentary evidence of such occurrence. Decision of the Corporation as regards to acceptance of the reasons stated by the supplier vis-à-vis imposition of penalty is final and binding on the Supplier.

- (ii) The "Force Majeure" risks are those which are beyond the control of either the Corporation or the Supplier and are defined as below:
 - a. War (whether declared or not), hostilities, invasion, acts of foreign enemies, rebellion, revolution, insurrection of military or usurped power, or civil war;
 - b. Contamination by radio activity from any nuclear fuel, or from any nuclear waste or radioactive materials;
 - c. Pressure waves caused by aircraft or other aerial devices travelling at sonic or supersonic speeds;
 - d. Acts of God (like floods, Inundation, tornadoes, Storm/ Tempest/ Hurricane/ Typhoon/ Cyclone/ Lightning or other atmospheric disturbances, Earthquake, Landslide/ Rockslide/ Subsidence or any loss or damage caused by forces of nature);
 - e. Damages due to any Political or Religious incidence;
 - f. Act of Terrorism:
 - g. Riots or commotion or disorder, unless solely restricted to employees of the Contractor or his Sub-Contractors and arising from the conduct of the Works;
 - h. Martial Law, damage from aircraft, nuclear fission, nuclear reaction, nuclear radiation, or radioactive contamination;
 - i. Fire (not caused by negligence of the Contractor/its Sub-Contractors/ their personnel); and
 - j. Other such causes, over which the Contractor has no control and are accepted as such, by the Engineer-in-Charge, whose decision shall be final and binding.

In the event of either party being rendered unable by "Force Majeure" to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under this Contract, the relative obligation of the party affected by such "Force Majeure" shall be treated as suspended for the period during which such "Force Majeure" cause lasts, provided the party alleging that it has been rendered unable, as aforesaid, thereby shall notify within 10 (ten) days of the alleged beginning and ending thereof giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of such cause.

10. NEEPCO reserves the right to award/split the Order to more than one Bidder depending upon the lowest rates of the individual items. The selected Bidder shall supply the materials strictly of required specification as mentioned in this Bid document at the rates finally approved by the Corporation. The Corporation also reserves the right to reject any or all Bids without assigning any reasons thereof. The Corporation is not bound to accept the lowest Bidder.

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11. In the event of disagreement / disputes arising in connection with execution of the order when place, which cannot be settled in an amicable manner between the Supplier and the Corporation, the matter shall be referred to arbitration. Such arbitration shall be governed by the provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act, 1940, Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time or any statutory modification or reenactment thereof for the time being in force. The venue of such arbitration will be Guwahati.

Any dispute arising out of this tender will be subjected to the jurisdiction of the Court of the District Magistrate, Guwahati, Assam. Any claim raised by the Supplier should be raised before the Chief General Manager (Tech), CSR, NEEPCO Ltd., R.G. Baruah Road, Guwahati-781005, Assam within 90 (ninety) days from the earliest date of occurrence of such claim. He is precluded from raising any claim after the expiry of the above period.

12. The Bids must be valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 (ninety) days from the date of opening of Bids. Bids without this minimum validity period shall be liable for rejection.
