## Detailed Notice Inviting BIDs from prospective bidders (Domestic Competitive Bidding) For

DESIGN, ENGINEERING, MANUFACTURING, TESTING, SUPPLY, DELIVERY INCLUDING SUPREVISION OF INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING OF OFAF COOLER ASSEMBLY WITH BLOWER UNIT REQUIRED FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE EXISTING WATER COOLED OIL COOLING SYSTEM OF 20MVA SINGLE PHASE GENERATOR TRANSFORMERS INSTALLED AT 4 X 50 MW KOPILI P.S., KHEP, NEEPCO LTD., UMRONGSO

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd., (NEEPCO), a Public Sector Enterprise under the Ministry of Power, Government of India, invites sealed bids with 120days validity from prospective experienced bidders under the Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding system through Domestic Competitive Bidding (DCB) route for awarding the contract of "Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Testing, Supply, Delivery and Supervision of Installation & Commissioning of OFAF Cooler Assembly with Blower Unit required for replacement of the existing Water Cooled Oil Cooling System of 20MVA, 11/220 KV Single Phase Generator Transformers installed at 4 X 50 MW Kopili Power Station of Kopili Hydro Electric Plant , NEEPCO Ltd. , Umrongso , Dima Hasao, Assam".

#### **DETAILS OF THE NIT:**

#### 1.0 **QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT OF BIDDERS:**

The bidder shall provide satisfactory evidence concerning the following:

#### 1.1 **Technical:**

- i) The bidder must be a Manufacturer of Heat Exchangers.
- ii) The intending bidder should have experience in design, manufacturing, testing, supply including installation and commissioning of different type of Heat Exchangers particularly Oil Force Air Force (OFAF) Type Coolers.

The above experience should be preferably with any Government department / PSU. Documentary evidence in support of experience and successful execution of supply order during last 7( seven) years ending March 2015 should be submitted.

iii) Bidders shall submit certificate / documentary evidence from the their users regarding satisfactory performance of the Heat Exchangers supplied by them.

### iv) The intending bidder should have experience in execution of similar supplies to any Government department/ PSU in last 7 years as follows:

a) At least one supply order of similar having contract value not less than Rs. 1,90,00,000/-

OR

b) At least two similar supply orders having contract value not less than Rs.1.40.00.000/- each

OR

c) At least three similar supply orders having contract value not less than Rs. 90,00,000/- each

OR

d) At least four similar supply orders having contract value not less than Rs. 50,00,000/- each

Documentary evidence (supply order copies) in support of execution of similar work must be submitted along with the bid. Non-submission of documents in support of similar experience may result in disqualification.

#### Similar supply/ work shall mean:

- Design , manufacturing , testing , supply including installation and commissioning of different type of Heat Exchangers to the Plants preferably owned by Govt. Dept/ PSU.
- v) Details like year-wise value of similar supply orders executed and documentary evidence of work completion alongwith order copies shall be furnished.

#### 1.2 Financial:

#### (a) Minimum Average Annual Turn Over (MAAT):

The average annual turnover of the bidder in the best 3 (three) financial years out of the last 5 (five) years financial year should not be less than Rs. 1, 00, 00,000 (One Crore). Other income will not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

(b) Complete Audited Annual Reports along with Audited Balance Sheets, Profit and Loss Account and other financial statements for the preceding 5(five) financial years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous Financial Year, along with Letter of adequacy/ solvency and commitment from their Bankers/Financial Institutions of International repute should be furnished along with their bids for evaluating the above financial criteria. In case where the audited results of the preceding financial years are not available, certified financial statements from a practicing Chartered Accountant will be also be considered acceptable.

Authenticated documentary evidence in support of qualifying requirements, as mentioned under Serial No. 1.0 above shall be submitted alongwith the containing Techno-Commercial bid alongwith Bid Guarantee. For qualifying requirements specified at Para 1.1 & 1.2 above, the documents should be in the form of Certificate of Clients/Owners. Bids submitted without fulfilling the qualifying requirements shall be rejected.

- 1.3 The bidder shall furnish copies of the following Registration Certificates:
  - (a) Registration for Service Tax;
  - (b) Registration for CST;
  - (c) PAN (Permanent Account Number) for Income Tax

- 1.4 The bidders shall also provide satisfactory evidence with respect to the following:
  - a. They do not anticipate change in the Ownership of their concern during the proposed period of work. If such a change is anticipated, the scope and effect thereof shall be defined.
  - b. They have adequate financial stability and status to meet the financial obligations pursuant to the scope of the works. They shall submit copies of their audited Annual Reports and balance sheet for the last 3 (three) years and the latest Sales Tax Clearance Certificate and latest Banker's certificate indicating amount in support of solvency.
  - c. In case bidders are unable to furnish such certificates, they shall give valid reason for the same. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if Sales Tax Clearance Certificate or the reasons for the bidders' inability to furnish such a certificate are not mentioned in the bids.
- 1.5 In addition, bidders shall satisfactorily establish that they fully meet the qualifying requirements specified in the accompanying Technical Specifications. This is essential for consideration of bidders' proposal.
- 1.6 Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any bank.
- 1.7 The above requirements are minimum and the Corporation reserves the right to request for any additional information and also reserves the right to reject the proposal of any bidder if, in the opinion of Owner, the qualification data furnished by the bidder is incomplete or the bidder is found to be not qualified to satisfactorily perform the works.
- 1.8 Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Corporation reserves the right to assess bidders' capability and capacity to perform the work, should the circumstances warrant such an assessment, in the overall interest of the Owner.
- 1.9 Each bidder shall submit only 1 (one) bid, either individually. A bidder who submits or participates in more than 1 (one) bid will be disqualified

#### 2 E-Tendering / E-Procurement:
